An attendee demonstrating Covid-19 symptoms	Everyone	Medium-High	All parents must be informed of self assessment requirement and undertake tests on themselves and children prior to attending training/matches.		

			<p>Attendance register to be completed, where attendees must confirm they have undertaken the self assessment.</p> <p>Attendance registers to be sent to Covid-19 Officer, records to be kept for 21 days, to support NHS Track and Trace.</p>		
Coaches Setup	Everyone	High-Medium	<p>Maximum of 30 people in a training session, including coaches.</p> <p>Players will have their own designated safe area, 2 metres apart, for holding named water bottles, sanitiser, equipment and assigned football.</p>	Coaches	Medium-Low
Players and Parents Area	Everyone	High-Medium	<p>Players will have their own designated safe area, complying with the 2m or 1m plus rule, for holding named water bottles, sanitiser, equipment and assigned football.</p> <p>Parents must maintain social distancing and must not stand in groups of more than 6 people.</p> <p>There will be a designated cleaning area to be used by players and coaches, before and after sessions, to sanitise their hands.</p>	<p>Coaches</p> <p>Players</p> <p>Parents</p> <p>Coaches</p>	Low
Coaches Equipment	Everyone	High-Medium	<p>No bibs to be shared, bibs can be given to players so they can wash them at home.</p> <p>All balls to be cleaned before and after session</p>	Coaches	Medium-Low

			<p>All cones to be cleaned before and after session</p> <p>All poles to be cleaned before and after session</p> <p>Goalnets to be cleaned before and after session</p> <p>Goalnets and corner flags to be cleaned before matches, at half time and after matches.</p>		
Players	Everyone	High-Medium	<p>All players to use hand sanitiser provided before and after training session</p> <p>Players and coaches to sanitise hands in between training activities and during half time of matches</p> <p>Players not to handle ball unless wearing gloves</p> <p>Wear appropriate footwear</p> <p>Wear shin pads</p> <p>Bring drinks and place in designated safe area</p> <p>Players must not touch coaching equipment with their hands i.e. cones or poles</p>	Coaches Players Parents	Medium-Low

			<p>Players must not play with another players football, unless a ball is being shared for a passing exercise or part of competitive training/match</p> <p>Players must always comply with the 2m or 1m plus rule, whilst not undertaking competitive training or matches</p>		
Facilities	Everyone	High-Medium	<p>Toilet facilities to be closed as per guidance</p> <p>Compound will only be accessible to coaches who will wear medical gloves. Coaches must comply with the 2m or 1m plus rule whilst in the compound.</p> <p>Only one coach is allowed in a shed at any one time.</p> <p>Designated cleaning area so players and coaches sanitise hands before and after the session</p>	Coaches	Low
Arrival and Departure	Everyone	High-Medium	<p>Traffic flow system is in place and must be followed at all times. Signs to be displayed prior to training and matches.</p> <p>On arrival, players must head for the designated cleaning area to sanitise their hands and the coach will then direct them to their designated safe area.</p>	Coaches Parents Players	Low

			<p>Attendance register must be completed by the parent/carer on arrival.</p> <p>Parents/Carers must not congregate, ideally, they will drop off and come back for pick up.</p> <p>On departure, players must sanitise their hands and will then be directed to their parent/carer.</p> <p>If the player has made their own way to training, they must sanitise their hands before making their own way home.</p>		
Coaching Sessions	Everyone	High-Medium	<p>All players have designated safe area.</p> <p>All players must follow coaches' instructions and behave accordingly. If behaviour is not acceptable, they will be asked to leave the session. Parents will be called for younger children.</p> <p>Players must not share equipment.</p> <p>Players must not touch equipment with their hands.</p> <p>Only goalkeepers can handle a ball, but they must wear gloves, which must be cleaned before the session.</p>	Coaches Players	Medium-Low
Members of the Public	Everyone	High-Medium	<p>Appropriate space must be allocated on the field to enable members of the public to safely walk past training sessions at a</p>	Coaches	Medium-Low

			<p>suitable distance, within social distancing guidelines.</p> <p>Age groups must stay in the areas identified on the Manor map for their training sessions, if training on a Saturday.</p>		
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
